 This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 ~~and 2~~ <sup>58</sup> in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.151 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.078 made by Mr and Mrs R G Marsa and noted in the Register on 3 August 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Richmond on 9 May 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr E R D Johnson, solicitor, on behalf of the applicants for the registrations, who informed me that his clients were willing for the land the subject of the Objection to be excluded from the Register Unit.

Having confirmed the registration in the Land section of the Register Unit with the exclusion of the Hill Inn, the subject of the Objection, and an area not included in the application for that registration by my decision, In the matter of West Stonedale Moor, Muker (No 1.) (1978) Reference No. 268/D/101, I confirm these registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
