



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Goatstones Crags or
Ravensheugh Crags Quarry, Simonburn,
Northumberland (No.1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.C.L.21 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Northumberland County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.23 made by Mr. L.G. Allgood and noted in the Register on 6th June 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Hexham on 17th July 1973. The hearing was attended by Mrs.C.S. Nixon, the Clerk of the Simonburn Parish Council, which applied for the registration, and by Mr. C.J. Thompson, solicitor, on behalf of Mr. Allgood.

Mrs. Nixon stated that she was concerned only about the registration of the land in question as common land and that she had no evidence to support the registration of the rights the subject of this dispute.

In the absence of any supporting evidence I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
