



In the Matter of Land known as Carr Road End
at the junction of Carr Road, Hundreds Lane and
the River Idle, Gringley on the Hill

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.77 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Nottinghamshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 17 made by The Everton Internal Drainage Board and noted in the Register on 7 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Nottingham on 13 January 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr F B Broughton and Mr W H Hunter, vice Chairman and Clerk respectively of Gringley on the Hill Parish Council. It appeared from correspondence which was produced to me that the Drainage Board was willing to withdraw its objection provided the Registration Plan was modified to exclude the site of the Board's Pumping Station between the River Idle and Mother Drain. The Parish Council accepted this modification.

For these reasons I confirm the registration subject to the modification that the site of the Drainage Board's Pumping Station the approximate position of which is shown edged red on the plan attached to the objection No. 17 dated 2 October 1970.
