



In the Matter of The Old Market Place, West Gate, Mansfield

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 34 on the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Nottinghamshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 3 made by the Mayor, Alderman and Bergesses of the Borough of Mansfield and noted in the Register on 6 May 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Nottingham on 14 January 1981. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard. The application had been withdrawn by letter dated 17 December 1980 addressed to the Commons Commissioners.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
