



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.229/D/12

In the Matter of Land opposite St Leonard's Church,
Sunningwell, Oxfordshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL 101 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Berkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.31 made by Mr T.Himpson and noted in the Register on 8th October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Oxford on 7th October 1975. The hearing was attended by Mrs Hall, a member of the Sunningwell Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr John Cole, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

Mrs Hall informed me that after a thorough investigation of the evidence the Parish Council had decided that it could not support the registration.

In the absence of any evidence I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
