

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



Reference No. 276/D/794

In the Matter of a tract of land called
Melinbarhedyn Common in the parishes of
Darowen and Penegoes

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 7 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 37 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 99 made by Mr W D Hughes and noted in the Register on 6 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llandrindod Wells on 13 March 1984. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard.

A letter had been received dated 6 March from Messrs Henry Evans, Roberts and Co, Solicitors of Machynlleth acting for Mr E Morris, the applicant at Entry No. 7 in the Rights Section enclosing a document signed by Mr Hughes, the Objector withdrawing his Objection.

For these reasons I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
