I would have expected a letter written in those circumstances to have made some reference to such earlier grazing. I do not accept that the practice of grazing the common with sheep from Penyrwalodd Farm began before 1926.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm either registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a decision of the High Court.
