## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos. 1 and 6 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 21 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 48 and 315 made by the Duke of Beauforts Brecon Estate Commoners Association and noted in the Register on 28 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 16 November 1983. The hearing was attended by Mr C C Boutcher in person and Mr G W Shellare, Chartered Surveyor for the Commoners Association.

It had been agreed that the registrations should be confirmed with the following modifications:-

Entry No. 1 limited to Estovers

Entry No. 6 limited to 70 sheep or stock equivalent.

For these reasons I confirm both the registrations with the modifications already mentioned.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
