



In the Matter of a Tract of land known as
Taulan Common, Merthyr Cynog

DECISION

This dispute relates to (1) the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 122 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 600 made by Mr S H Price and noted in the Register on 18 November 1971 and (2) the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership Section of the same Register Unit occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 2 in the Ownership Section of the same Register Unit in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 20 October 1983. The hearing was attended by Mrs E M Morgan on behalf of the County Land Agent and Valuer. Mrs Morgan informed me that the registration at Entry No. 2 in the Ownership Section had been withdrawn and removed from the register in 1971 and I had before me a letter from the Solicitors acting for Mr S H Price stating that Objection No. 600 had been withdrawn.

For these reasons I confirm the registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Rights and Ownership Sections.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
