DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 67 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Radnorshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 968 made by R K Jones and noted in the Register on 10 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llandrindod Wells on 10 November 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Gareth Morris of Messrs Dilwyn Jones & Son on behalf of the Objector who produced a letter dated 9 November 1977 from Messrs Vaughan & Davies solicitors for Major C J L Lewis agreeing that I should refuse to confirm all the Entries.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
