



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 276/D/17 & 18

In the Matter of Cefn Llanbister,
Llanbister, Radnor D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 12 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 21 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Radnorshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 528 made by Cefn Hill Commoners and noted in the Register on 29 September 1970 and Objection No 583 made by J E Price and noted in the Register on 29 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llandrindod Wells on 26 May 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Gareth Morris of Messrs Dilwyn Jones & Sons on behalf of the Association and Mr J E Price who produced a letter signed by Mr & Mrs Hartland the applicants for rights under Entry No 12 whereby they agreed that such Entry should be modified so as to confer only the right to graze one sheep on the Unit Land.

For these reasons I confirm the registration modified as aforesaid.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
