REVISED DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos 28 and 29 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 1 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Radnorshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos 805 and 806 both made by Mr R A Banks and both noted in the Register on 24 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llandrindod Wells on 10 November 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr R A Banks, Messrs T & S E Davies, the applicants for Rights under Entry No 20 and Mr K F Whitehead, the applicant for Rights under Entry No 28, did not appear.

By a decision dated 4 January 1978 I stated incorrectly that the hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard and that I must therefore treat the two registrations as undisputed and confirm the registrations. When giving this decision I overlooked the appearance of Mr Banks and apologise for this error. I withdraw my said decision dated 4 January and give this decision in lieu thereof.

In the absence of the two applicants for rights to support their claims I have no alternative but to refuse to confirm these Entries.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
