

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 276/D/387

In the Matter of land known as The Grove to the east of Caersws Bridge and on the south bank of the River Severn, Llandinam

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 26 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Montgomeryshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 3 made by E M Kinsey and noted in the Register on 12 November 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Welshpool on 4 June 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J Hollis, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Mr Kinsey. The registration was made on the application of Caersws Amateur Football Club and the ground of the Objection is that the land was not Common Land at the date of registration.

It appeared from a letter dated 2 June 1980 from the Secretary of the Football Club that the Club wished to withdraw its application, and accordingly I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
