



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 276/D/456

In the Matter of Land north of Lake Vyrnwy
in the parishes of Llanwddyn Hirant and Llangynog

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.112 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 136 made by Liverpool Corporation and noted in the Register on 1 December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Welshpool on 11 December 1980. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, other than the Registration Authority, represented by Mr H J Cave.

I understand that Severn Water Authority is successor to Liverpool Corporation as owner of the land in question. There are no Entries in the Rights Section: the registration was made on the application of the Ramblers Association.

A written request has been received signed by (inter Alia) The Ramblers Association, requesting that confirmation of the registration be refused and in these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
