DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 17 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Radnorshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 1 made by C B Williams and noted in the Register on 5 May 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llandrindod Wells on 24 May 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr P J Medlicott of Messrs George H Medlicott & Son on behalf of the Objector. The applicants for rights did not appear.

Mr Medlicott told me that the land in question had been inclosed pursuant to an inclosure award dated 1873 and had been a private ownership ever since and was now an integral part of Mr Williams' property and that no common rights had been exercised over the land in question. In the absence of both the claimants for rights to contest Mr Williams' claim I must refuse to confirm all the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
