

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 58/D/17

In the Matter of Part of Radnor Forest  
(Imperial Metal Industries Firing Range)  
Llanfihangel Nantmellan and New Radnor  
Powys

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 7 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.61 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 931 made by Imperial Metal Industries (Kynoch) Ltd and noted in the Register on 10th November 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llandrindod Wells on 6th January 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr. G.W. Roddick of Counsel, instructed by Messrs, Dilwyn Jones & Sons on behalf of the Applicant Edward Thomas of Knowle Farm New Radnor, and by Mr. Vernon Fugh of Counsel, instructed by Messrs. Leo Abse & Cohen, on behalf of the Objector.

I was informed by Counsel that the parties had agreed that I should confirm the registration with the variation that "275 sheep units" should be substituted in the Register for "400 sheep units".

For this reason I confirm that registration with the following modification :- that the figure 275 be substituted for the figure 400 in the fourth column of the Register.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
