



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 276/D/454-455

In the Matter of pieces of land called Llanymynech
Hill and Fron-Goch, Carreghofa

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 105 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 134 made by D C Thomas and Objection No. 158 made by Steetley (MFG) Ltd noted in the Register on 29 October 1970 and 1 November 1971 respectively.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Welshpool on 11 December 1980. The hearing was attended by Mrs G M Siddons, Footpaths Secretary of Welshpool Branch of the Ramblers Association, Mr G A Lewis, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Mr D C Thomas, and Mr J Humphreys a member of Carreghofa Community Council.

The registration was made on the application of the Ramblers Association, which has requested refusal of confirmation of the registration. There are no Entries in the Rights Section. Mr Lewis informed me that Mr Thomas's Objection related only to the part of the land called Fron-Goch, but Objection No. 158 appears to relate to the whole, and having regard to the request of the Ramblers Association, I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
