



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of South Eppynt Mountain in

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 30 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 57 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 498 made by South Eppynt Graziers and noted in the Register on 18 November 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 13 July 1983. The hearing was attended by Mr E C J Selwyn of Messrs Jeffreys and Powell, Solicitors of Brecon, appearing for the Objectors.

Mr Selwyn produced a letter from a Chartered Surveyor acting for Mr Tandor Thomas, the applicant at Entry No. 30, stating that Mr Thomas agreed to reduce his claim to 214 sheep. Mr Selwyn then withdrew his client's objection.

For these reasons I confirm the registration with the following modifications, that the number of sheep be reduced from 500 to 214.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
