DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 10 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.12 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 830 made by Begwns Commoners Association and noted in the Register on 30 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llandrindod Wells on 7 January 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr. R A Phillips, one of the applicants, and by Mr. E R Lewis, the Secretary of the Begwns Commoners Association. The parties have agreed that I should confirm the registration subject to the modifications specified below.

For this reason I confirm the registration with the following modifications: (a) delete the figures and words, "537 sheep 36 ponies 18 cattle" in the fourth column of the Register and substitute "507 sheep, 34 ponies, 17 cattle"; and (b) delete 0.5. No. 543 in the fifth column of the Register.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
