

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 276/U/17

In the Matter of The Patch, Bronllys, Brecknock BC

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as The Patch, Bronllys, Brecknock BC being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 125 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Breconshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon thepublic notice of this reference G Balfour Chichester claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Brecon on 13 July 1977.

Mr R N O Tyler of Messrs Woosnam & Tyler appeared for Mr Balbur Chichester.

By my decision under Reference No 276/U/ll I decided that Mr Dalfour Chichester is the freehold owner of the land comprised in the Manor of Cantrescliffe. Mr Tyler identified the land in question on the map annexed to the conveyance dated 1 October 1912, referred to in my said decision as being comprised in that Manor.

On this evidence I am satisfied that G balfour Chichester is the owner of the land under section $\delta(2)$ of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1)of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
