



In the Matter of a Tract of Land, part  
of Mynydd Epynt, Crickadarn

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos. in the Land and Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 110 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council occasioned by Objection Nos. 103, 423, 506, 729-731, 747-749, 719-759 noted in the Register.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 14 March 1983. The hearing was attended by Mr Vanhees, Solicitor, appeared for Mr A T Jones and Mr E P Davies and Messrs Jeffreys and Powell appeared for Mr G H Morgan and Mr E J T Jones.

Objection No. 403 was withdrawn except as to Entry Nos. 4, 7, 10 and 17 in the Rights Section which were themselves withdrawn.

Objection No. 103 was withdrawn as to Entries in either the Land or Rights Section.

Objection No. 506 was withdrawn except as to Entry Nos. 4, 7 and 17.

Objection Nos. 719, 729-731, 747-749 and 759 were withdrawn.

For these reasons I confirm the registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry Nos. 1-3, 5-6, 509, 11-16, 20-24, and 27-42 in the Rights Section and I refuse to confirm the registrations at Entry Nos. 4, 7, 10 and 17 in the said Rights Section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
