

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 276/D/146 & 147

In the Matter of Tract of land known as Cilsanws Common, Merthyr Tydfil BC

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and Entries 1-26 inclusive in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 80 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Breconshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 172 made by British Dreding (South Wales) Ltd and noted in the Register on 11 Marsh 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecom on 13 July 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr J Ellis Secretary of the Welsh Federation Commoners Association and Mr R J Roberts on behalf of the Welsh Mational Water Development Authority.

By a letter dated 8 July 1977 addressed to the Office of the Commons Commissioners Messrs Lean & Lean withdrew the above-mentioned Objection. Mr Ellis made an application for costs but when asked by me if the Objection was made bona fide he conceded that it was and did not pursue his application.

For this reason I confirm all the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
