



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 276/D/598-599

In the Matter of the tract of land known as The
Common, Llangattock

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos. 5 8 9 11 13 and 10 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.28 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Breconshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 254,307,308,356,380 and 332 made by the Chairman of the Duke of Beaufort & Breconshire Estate Commoners Association and noted in the Register on 24 August and 7 September 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 26 October 1982. The hearing was attended by Mr G W Shellard of Messrs. Henry Jones and Hobbs, Solicitors, Swansea for the Commoners Association and Mr H Cave for Powys County Council the Registration Authority.

None of the rights applicants appeared or was represented.

Mr Shellard said that the applicant at Entry No. 5 had ^{reduced} ~~redescribed~~ his claim from 15 sheep or equivalent stock to 5 sheep or 1 cow or 1 horse and the applicant at Entry No 10 had reduced his claim from 40 sheep or equivalent stock to 22 sheep or 4 horses or 4 cattle and his client's objections to these two applications as modified was withdrawn.

For these reasons I confirm the registrations at Entry Nos 5 and 10 with the modifications mentioned and I refuse to confirm any of the other registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
