

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 276/D/149

In the Matter of Tract of land known as Y Golfa, Castle Caereinion, Hontgomery D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 10 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 4 (M) in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Montgomeryshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 108 made by R P Turner and noted in the Register on 29 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Welshpool on 8 December 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr W D Cooke of Messrs Harrison & Sons on behalf of the personal representatives of the late Mr R P Turner who had objected to the Right of turbary claimed by Mr & Mrs Jones at Entry No 10 and he withdrew that Objection.

Mrs Jones also appeared and invited me to modify their Entry No 10 so as to conform with the agreement made between the graziers, referred to in Mr Turner's Objection. It is apparent from a perusal of the Rights Section that a scale of grazing has been agreed viz 5 sheep = 1 head of cattle or 1 pony.

For these reasons I confirm the registration with the following modifications viz by inserting in column 4 after the words 63 sheep the word for 12 cattle or 12 ponies.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
