



In the Matter of Trefil Las and Twyn Bryn March  
Rassau

DECISION

On 27 March 1984 I held a hearing at Brecon to determine disputes arising from applications made in the Right Section of Register Unit No.CL.14 and CL.15 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council. CL.15 relates to the land above mentioned and CL.14 refers to neighbouring land known as Trefil Ddu, Tredegar. In each case the objections were made by the Duke of Beaufort's Estate Commoners Association.

Mr Percival Hopkins of Nantmelyn Dukestown registered an application at Entry No. 17 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.14 as owner of Hiegau Farm to graze 100 sheep 10 cattle and 10 horses and to cut and haul rushes and fern.

An objection (No. 603) was lodged against the application stating that the applicant was not entitled to graze CL.14 and that his application should rightly have been made in respect of Register Unit No.CL.15 and that there was no objection to the application being transferred from CL.14 to CL.15.

Mr Hopkins did not attend the hearing of either matter either in person or through a representative. According to my notes made at the hearing the objection to Mr Hopkins application was withdrawn. I am now informed that the true arrangement was that if Mr Hopkins' application in respect of CL.14 was withdrawn the objectors would agree to the same application being entered in the Rights Section of CL.15 and Confirmed. Mr Hopkins' farm is close to CL.15 but some distance from CL.14.

For these reasons I confirm a registration in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.15 in the terms of Entry No.17 in the Rights Section of Register Unit CL.14

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
