



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos.31/3/36-39

In the Matter of Ragleth Hill,
Church Stretton, Salop.(No.2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.103 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Salop County Council and are occasioned by Objections Nos.164 and 163 both made by Mr.A.P.Prinç and Objections Nos.156 and 155 both made by Mr.G.B.Richards and all noted in the Register on 17th August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Shrewsbury on 13th June 1974. The hearing was attended by Mr.J.C.Bowdler, solicitor, on behalf of Mr.W.Wilding, who applied for the registration and by Mr.D.Salt, solicitor, on behalf of Mr.Richards.

No evidence was called in support of the registration. In the absence of any evidence I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
