



In the Matter of Knowle Green, Knowle St. Giles,  
Somerset

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Knowle Green, Knowle St. Giles, being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG.83 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Somerset County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Cricket Malherbie Ltd claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Taunton on 23 October 1984. At the hearing the Knowle St. Giles Parish Meeting was represented by Mr C J Edge, its Chairman. Mr Edge had no evidence as to the ownership of the land in question.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Somerset County Council, as registration authority, to register the Yeovile District Council as the owner of the land under section 8 (3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
