



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.232/D/16

In the Matter of Merridge Hill (part),
Spaxton, Somerset.

DECISION //

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos. 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL 32 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Somerset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.0/20 made by Mr H.P.Warlington and noted in the Register on 30th April 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Taunton on 25th March 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr D.S.Rowell, of counsel, on behalf of the applicants for the registrations, and by Mr J.F.Whigham on behalf of the Objector. Mr Whigham informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
