



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.232/D/95

In the Matter of Merridge Hill,
Spaxton, Somerset (No.2).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos.1,2,3,5 and 6 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL 29 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Somerset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.0/19 made by Mr H.P.Warmington and noted in the Register on 21st April 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Taunton on 25th March 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr P.M.Boyce, solicitor, on behalf of Mr W.A.Porter, the applicant for the registration at Entry No.1, and Mr P.J.Coles, the applicant for the registration at Entry No.6, by Mr D.C.Rowell, of counsel, on behalf of Mr E.W.House, the applicant for the registration at Entry No.2, and Mr H.J.Porter, the applicant for the registration at Entry No.3, by Mr R.G.Ash, solicitor, on behalf of Mr D.G.Heal, the applicant for the registration at Entry No.5, and by Mr J.F.Whigham, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

The Objection related to only part of the land comprised in the Register Unit and since I have by my decision in In the Matter of Merridge Hill, Spaxton (No.1), Ref.No.232/D/94 excluded this part of the land from the Register Unit, it only remains for me to confirm the registrations the subject of this dispute.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
