



In the Matter of Small area & land at  
the North East of Crook Peak, Compton Bishop  
Sedgemoor D. Somerset.

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No 1 in Land Section  
and Entry Nos 1, 2 & 3 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 176 in the  
Register of Common Land maintained by the Somerset County Council and are occasioned  
by Objection No 0/805 made by the Somerset County Council and noted in the Register  
on 4th September 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into these disputes at Taunton  
on 22 May 1975.

The hearing was attended by Mr Edwards on behalf of the Somerset County Council  
and Mr Frankpitt of Messrs John Hodge & Co. Solicitor to the claimants for common  
rights.

Mr. Frankpitt was satisfied that the County Councils objection was well founded  
and was content that I should refuse to confirm the above-mentioned registrations.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the said registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971

to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law

may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him,

require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
