nese disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No 1 in Land Section and Entry Nos 1, 2 & 3 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 176 in the register of Common Land maintained by the Somerset County Council and are occasioned Objection No 0/805 made by the Somerset County Council and noted in the Register 4th September 1972.
