



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.232/D/4

In the Matter of The Village Green near the Post Office,
Brompton Ralph, Somerset.

DECISION //

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG 64 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Somerset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.0/214 made by the Clerk of the former Somerset County Council and noted in the Register on 5th November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Taunton on 8th October 1974. The hearing was attended by Mr. D.L. Edwards, solicitor, on behalf of the Somerset County Council.

There was no appearance on behalf of the Brompton Ralph Parish Council, which applied for the registration, but by letter dated 30th September 1974 the Clerk of the Parish Council informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners that his Council had resolved to "withdraw" its application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
