



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.232/D/12

In the Matter of Winsford Hill, Drayton Knapp,  
Varle Hill, and Ashway Side, Dulverton and  
Winsford, Somerset.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.175 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Somerset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.0/823 made by Mr. C.P.T. Everard and noted in the Register on 5th September 1972.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modification:- the substitution of the number "35" for the number "50" and the insertion after the word "Ponies" of the words "(no stallion or colt over 12 months of age to be included in the Herd)".
