



In the Matter of The Landing, Fishlake,
South Yorkshire

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.154 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the South Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council and are occasioned by the conflicting registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL.333 and Entry No. 3 in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL.401 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Doncaster on 17 January 1984. The hearing was attended by Mr P R Pennington, Solicitor, on behalf of the Doncaster Metropolitan Borough Council, and Mr W.K. Irving, the Legal Services Officer of the South Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council. There was no appearance on behalf of the Fishlake Parish Council, the applicant for the registration.

Neither Mr Pennington nor Mr Irving adduced any evidence in support of the registration

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
