



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 233/D/38

In the Matter of an elongated area situated on the West Side of the former Norton Green Sewage Works extending southwards to the westside of Canal Cottage, Norton Green, Staffordshire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. Area No. 5 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 1A in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Staffordshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 2 made by G J A Barber and noted in the Register on 21 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Stoke-on-Trent on 14 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr B Baker of the National Farmers' Union for Mr Barber and Mrs Ingram for Stoke City Council. Mr Baker and Mrs Ingram informed me that their respective clients had agreed to ask me not to confirm the registration.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
