



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Chippenhall Green or
Mill Green, Mid Suffolk D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 4 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 29 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former East Suffolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 104 made by Messrs Gorham & Webster and noted in the Register on 30 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Ipswich on 27 October 1976. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard.

Mr J P Consterdine signed a request to have this dispute disposed of without a hearing, as ~~he~~ the successor to Mr Boast, the applicant for Rights under Entry No 4. That request had not been signed by all the persons entitled to be heard and for this reason this dispute was referred to me. The said request was that I should confirm the Entry at No 4 and it was signed by the Objectors and in these circumstances I confirm the said Entry.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
