



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Little Blakenham  
Common, Little Blakenham, Mid

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL.124 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former East Suffolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 101 made by Violet May Plummer and noted in the Register on 30 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Ipswich on 11 February 1975. The hearing was attended by Miss K. Akester, clerk of Little Blakenham Parish Council and Mr. J.H. Knott, the successor to Violet May Plummer, the owner of the land in question. Miss Akester stated that there was no evidence of the exercise of common rights over the land in question at any time during living memory and did not contend that I should confirm the registration.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
