## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.VG.92 in the Register of Town or Village Green maintained by the Suffolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 63 made by the Administrators of the late C D B Starkie Bence and noted in the Register on 30 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Ipswich on 19 February 1985. The hearing was attended by Mr J Warren, Solicitor, on behalf of Miss A M Ross, the surviving administratrix of the late Mr Starkie Bence.

Mr Warren informed me that Miss Ross did not wish to pursue the objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state ac ase for the decilsion of the High Court.
