



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Peto's Pond,  
Blundeston, East Suffolk.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.C.L.85 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the East Suffolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.103 made by Messrs. Cadge and Gilbert and noted in the Register on 30th September 1970.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely, the exclusion of so much of the land comprised in the Register Unit as lies to the north of the north-western boundary of the land edged red on the plan attached to the particulars of the terms, such boundary being 100 feet from Church Road.
