



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 234/D/111

In the Matter of The Green,
Brockley, Suffolk (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 50 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Suffolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 8 made by the former Thingoe Rural District Council and noted in the Register on 10 February 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bury St Edmunds on 19 January 1982. The hearing was attended by Mr K A Lewis, the applicant for the registration.

The land comprised in the Register Unit has recently been sold to the Brockley Parish Council for open space purposes. In these circumstances Mr Lewis, with the agreement of the St Edmundsbury District Council and the Parish Council, decided that he did not wish to support the registration.

Therefore I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
