DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. VG.77 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Suffolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 73 made by the Hessett Parish Council and noted in the Register on 15 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Ipswich on 19 February 1985. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, but a son of Mr A P Baulby, the applicant for the registration, who is ill, informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioner by letter that his father did not wish to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
