

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 234/D/101

In the Matter of Winston Green, Winston, Suffolk (NO. 2)

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.144 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Suffolk County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.VG.21 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bury St. Edmunds on 13 February 1979. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, but before the hearing solicitors acting for Mr A C Jennings, the applicant for the registratic informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners by letter that Mr Jennings did not wish to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require no to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
