In the Matter of Damqueting Mouse Site, Evell, Epson and Ewell, Surrey.

DESISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 6 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Survey County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 70 made by the former Epson and Ewell Borough Council and noted in the Register on 6 April 1970 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 27 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 15 June 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Menneth Day, the applicant for the registration and the conflicting registration, and Mr A B Scholfield, solicitor, on behalf of the Epsom and Ewell Borough Council.

Mr Day stated that he did not wish to support the registration. In these circumstances, I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in <u>point</u> of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
