

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/194

In the Matter of Bisley Green, Bisley Surrey Heath B.C.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG. 65 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL.30 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 14 February 1977. The hearing was attended by Miss P J Fishwick on behalf of Surrey County Council and Mr P C Conway Chairman of the Bisley Parish Council. Mr Conway withdrew the registration made by his Council.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
