



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/170

In the Matter of Boundary Road Recreation Ground,  
Woking

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entries Nos 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.125 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 124 made by Woking U D C and noted in the Register on 22 July 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 14 February 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr G Gilmour solicitor on behalf of Woking B C. Neither of the applicants for rights appeared to support their claims for rights.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of this decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
