## COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



In the Matter of Castle Green, Chobham, Woking, Surrey.

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 101 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by Objection No 102 made by the Horsell Common Preservation Society and noted in the Register on 26 June 1970 and Objection No. 246 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 21 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 7 October 1977. The hearing was not attended by the applicants for the registration.

I therefore refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
