



In the Matter of Children's Playground and
Roadside Waste, Cranleigh, Surrey

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 14 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 50 made by the British Railways Board and noted in the Register on 17 March 1970 and Objection No. 329 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 9 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 19 March 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council and Mr R Hart, Solicitor, on behalf of the Waverley District Council, the successor authority of the former Hambledon Rural District Council, whose application was noted in the Register under Section 4(4) of the Commons Registration Act 1965. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Sir Anthony Bonham, Bt, the applicant for the registration.

Mr Cotter informed me that the County Council wished to exclude from Objection No. 329 certain land originally covered by it, and that the County Council also wished to support Objection No. 50 save in so far as it related to certain land originally covered by it. Mr Cotter produced a plan, which I have marked "G.D.S.1", showing the land still sought to be excluded from the Register Unit.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification: namely, the exclusion of the land shown coloured pink on the plan marked "G.D.S.1".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
