

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/303

In the Matter of Coldharbour Green, Capel and Holmwood, Surrey (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 429 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 728 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 1 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 14 December 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr B Cotter, Solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council. There was no appearance on behalf of the Capel Parish Council, the applicant for the registration. However, the Objection relates only to certain highway land shown coloured pink on the plan attached to the application.

In these corcumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification namely, the exclusion of the land shown coloured pink on the plan attached to the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
