



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/379-381

In the Matter of Effingham Quarry, Tandridge D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entries Nos. 1-4 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 1 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objections No. 142 and No. 401 made by Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 1 September and 19 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorking on 27 October 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B Cotter, Solicitor, of the Surrey County Council and by no other person. The Objections related to pieces of land shown on the plans accompanying the objections, the pieces having been incorporated into the highway. I confirm the registrations, modified by excluding these pieces from the land comprised in this Register Unit.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
