



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entries No. 1 and No. 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 258 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by Objections No. 439 made by Surrey County Council and No. 712 made by the National Trust and noted in the Register respectively on 19 October 1970 and 2 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorking on 10 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B Cotter, Solicitor of Surrey County Council and by Mrs G A Shipp, an officer of and representing the National Trust. The applicant for registration at the Entries in the Rights Section was Mrs B M Tussler who was not present or represented at the hearing. In the absence of evidence to support the Entries, I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
